

# General Security Awareness Training (GSAT)

## Online GSAT Course for the Aviation Industry

General Security Awareness Training (GSAT) is a requirement of EC Regulation 2320. In the UK, GSAT applies to all applicants for, and holders of a full pass granting unescorted access to the RZ (Restricted Zone), except where the applicant or pass holder is already in receipt of equivalent or better training (known as equivalence).

From 28 January 2008 all applicants must provide evidence that they have successfully completed a full GSAT course or provide evidence of equivalence (equivalent or better training). By January 2009 anyone who was the holder of a full pass at 28 January 2008 must have provided evidence that they have fulfilled the GSAT requirements.

### Course Overview

- **The GSAT course aims to ensure that all students are aware of the security threat and measures in place at the airport where they will be working**
- **The course will familiarise students with the nature of the threat to aviation and the basic security measures in place to counter that threat**
- **The course will ensure that students understand the core objectives and organisation of aviation security and the part they can play in contributing to the security of the airport**

The course is divided up into 5 modules. Each module has an associated assessment (see GSAT Questions).

- **Threat to Aviation**
- **Objectives and Organisation of Aviation Security**
- **Restricted Zone Protection and Access Control**
- **Prohibited Articles**
- **The Trainee's Role in Aviation Security**

The total course run time is approximately 2.5 hours.

### TryByte LMS (Learning Management System)

Trends in current business operations and new regulations place heavy emphasis on compliance, audit trails and reporting requirements. The need for a solution that meets an entire organisation's training, learning and development, Human Resources and compliance can be easily, quickly and cost effectively managed through TryByte LMS.

### GSAT Course Modules

Each module is run as a presentation within a captive LMS system. What this means to the student is that the module is not dependent on them having presentation software on their system.

The LMS system allows you to leave the presentation at any point and when you return, it remembers where you were. Within the presentations you can move backwards, forwards or jump to different slides.

### GSAT Revision Questions

Within each module there are several revision questions which are generally multiple choice. These are non scoring questions and as such do not contribute to the students final module score, however, they are an important aid to learning. These revision questions can be revisited at any time.

### GSAT Questions (Assessments)

GSAT questions are in the form of multiple choice, multiple answer and true / false statements.

Each module assessment is made up of 10 random questions based on the module subject matter. A student can take each assessment several times, however, after three attempts the module assessment is locked and TryByte Training will contact the student to offer assistance and guidance (a locked assessment does not prevent the student from replaying the course module or proceeding within the course and TryByte will unlock the module after reviewing the assessment results).

TryByte take their role within Aviation Security very seriously. We ensure that each module assessment has a pass mark that must be attained prior to final certification. The pass mark is set at 75% which is the standard accepted within the industry

Assessments can be taken at any time and are not dependent on the module. After completing an assessment a student can instantly see their results. These results show the correct and incorrectly answered questions. TryByte monitor all test results.

### GSAT Video Content

Several modules contain DfT approved video.

Each video is designed to enforce the learning process and free runs within its own window. Students can replay a video at any time after starting the module.

The videos have been created so as to provide quick download times, however, it is advisable that a reasonable speed internet link is available.

The course video content requires Windows Media Player. This software is free and can be downloaded from Microsoft. The download link is available within each module showing video.

### GSAT Training Certificate

On course completion, students will be sent via UK post, a TryByte General Security Awareness Training (GSAT) course certificate. Each certificate displays the students name and unique serial number. This certificate confirms course completion and must be presented in its original form to a UK airport pass issuing department. Certificates remain the property of the Department for Transport (DfT).
